





General Notes:

- 1. The Zero Point is the intersection of the Datum Water Line (dwl) with the stemface.
- 2. Positions are measured fwd and aft (marked "-") of the Zero Point.
- 3. Heights are measured above and below (marked "-") the dwl.
- Offsets are measured each side of the fore-&-aft centreline.
- Waterlines are designated "wl" followed by their height.
- 6. Buttocks are designated "b" followed by their offset.
- 7. Diagonals are designated "d" followed by their start height on the centreline and their angle to it.
- Offsets on diagonals are measured down the angle of the diagonal.
- 9. Offsets are to inside of skin unless noted otherwise.

Specific Notes:

- Units are WEST bonded & coated.
- The fronts & tops contribute to the structure.
- Fronts & tops are filleted to hull skin.
- Drawing shows Port Unit Stbd Unit is a mirror image.
