




Note: Support shelf on 15 x 15 cleating. Shelf widths are to inboard face of fiddle – see Standard Detail



Notes:
 Cooker sits on top on Unit Top and should preferably be mounted in gimbals.
 Sink is let through or mounted under Unit Top.
 Which side is sink and which is cooker is builders' choice.



General Notes:

1. The Zero Point is the intersection of the Datum Water Line (dwl) with the stemface.
2. Positions are measured fwd and aft (marked "-") of the Zero Point.
3. Heights are measured above and below (marked "-") the dwl.
4. Offsets are measured each side of the fore-&-aft centreline.
5. Waterlines are designated "wl" followed by their height.
6. Buttocks are designated "b" followed by their offset.
7. Diagonals are designated "d" followed by their start height on the centreline and their angle to it.
8. Offsets on diagonals are measured down the angle of the diagonal.
9. Offsets are to inside of skin unless noted otherwise.

Specific Notes:

1. Units are WEST bonded & coated.
2. The fronts & tops contribute to the structure.
3. Fronts & tops are filleted to hull skin.
4. Drawing shows Port Unit - Stbd Unit is a mirror image
5. No shelf in Sink Unit
